SVBB is a large brass and percussion ensemble formed in the tradition of the British brass band. A traditional brass band strives to emulate the rich, full sound of a pipe organ. In order to achieve this unique sound, they utilize the following instruments: Bb Cornets, Eb Soprano Cornet, Flugel Horn, Eb Tenor Horns (instead of Horns in F), Euphoniums and Baritones, Tenor Trombones, Bass Trombone, Bb and Eb Bases and percussionists playing a wide variety of instruments.

The mission of the Silicon Valley Brass Band, a member-driven musical organization, is to entertain its audiences with a wide variety of musical styles in the brass band tradition. We will present high quality musical performances that display the unique sound and style of a British style brass band.
